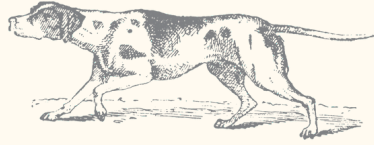

Luxury Bordeaux Experience (€90.00pp)

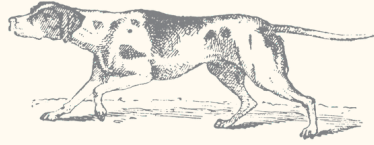
